At TEBODRA on 2 Dec 42 Sgt Wooster was in command of a gun in an anti tank position when 3 tanks broke through into the forward company of 2 Hampshires. Sgt Wooster's position was well concealed but from it he was unable to engage the tanks accurately. He therefore ordered his gun to be run up into the open. This was done in the face of heavy fire from the tanks and the gun was re-mounted on its platform. Sgt Wooster then engaged the tanks directing the fire of his gun with great coolness.
